A BILL

To direct the Secretary concerned to reinstate a member involuntarily separated from the Armed Forces solely on the basis of the refusal of such member to receive a vaccination against COVID-19.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

1	SECTION 1. REINSTATEMENT OF MEMBERS INVOLUN-
2	TARILY SEPARATED FROM THE ARMED
3	FORCES ON THE BASIS OF REFUSAL TO RE-
4	CEIVE VACCINATIONS AGAINST COVID-19.
5	(a) Reinstatement.—At the election of a covered
6	individual, the Secretary concerned shall reinstate such
7	covered individual—
8	(1) as a member of the Armed Force concerned;
9	and
10	(2) in the grade held by such covered individual
11	immediately before the involuntary separation of the
12	covered individual.
13	(b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:
14	(1) The term "covered individual" means an in-
15	dividual involuntarily separated from the Armed
16	Forces solely on the basis of the refusal of such indi-
17	vidual to receive a vaccination against COVID-19.
