3	(a) In General.—Chapter 313 of title 49, United							
4	States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-							
5	lowing:							
6	"§ 31318. Treatment of transportation of goods from a							
7	port							
8	"The transportation of goods from a port of entry							
9	and another place within the same State as part of trade,							
10	traffic, or transportation originating outside such State or							
11	the United States by commercial motor vehicle shall not							
12	be considered interstate transportation for purposes of re-							
13	quirements relating to commercial driver's licenses under							
14	this chapter.".							
15	(b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The analysis for chap-							
16	ter 313 of title 49, United States Code, is amended by							
17	adding at the end the following:							
	"31318. Treatment of transportation of goods from a port.".
