# A BILL

To protect the Second Amendment rights of adults whose use of marijuana is permitted by State or Tribal law.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Gun Rights And Mari-  
5 juana Act” or the “GRAM Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROTECTION OF SECOND AMENDMENT RIGHTS OF**  
2 **ADULTS WHOSE USE OF MARIJUANA IN AC-**  
3 **CORDANCE WITH STATE OR TRIBAL LAW.**

4 Section 921(a) of title 18, United States Code, is  
5 amended by adding at the end the following:

6 “(38) The term ‘unlawful user of or addicted to any  
7 controlled substance’ shall not include a person by reason  
8 of unlawful use of or addiction to marihuana (as defined  
9 in section 102(16) of the Controlled Substances Act) if—

10 “(A) the person resides in a State, or on lands  
11 under the jurisdiction of an Indian tribe (as defined  
12 in section 4 of the Indian-Self Determination and  
13 Education Assistance Act), the laws of which permit  
14 the use of marihuana by an adult; and

15 “(B) the use of marihuana by the person in the  
16 State or on those lands, as the case may be, does  
17 not violate the laws of the State or Indian tribe, as  
18 the case may be.”.
