Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting \$1,040,000 in community project funding for the Fort Pierce, FL Section 203/403 shore protection project in the FY26 Energy and Water Resources Development appropriations bill. The entity to receive funding for this project is the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Jacksonville District at 701 San Marco Blvd, Jacksonville, FL, 32207. The funding will be matched with \$560,000 in non-federal resources and be used to will add coastal structures (t-groins) to provide future cost savings and extend the period of nourishment from 2 to 4 years.

The project has a Federal Nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized by Section 203 of WRDA 1986 (PL 99-662) and submitted to the office of the Assistant Secretary of the Army for Civil Works (OASACW) in 2017.
