I am requesting \$6,400,000 in funding for the Village of North Palm Beach Public Works Facility Development in Palm Beach County in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Village of North Palm Beach, located at 501 US Highway 1 North Palm Beach, FL 33408. The funding will support the design and construction of a modern public works complex to house fleet maintenance, sanitation operations, stormwater and utility support functions, and emergency response staging. This is an appropriate use of taxpayers funds because the facility will improve service delivery, reduce long-term operating costs, enhance employee safety, and strengthen the Village's ability to respond to hurricanes, flooding events, and other emergencies. The project directly supports essential municipal services relied upon daily by residents and businesses throughout the community.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C.5305(a)(2).
