I am requesting \$2,000,000 in funding for the California Boulevard Phase 3 Corridor Study and Design in the City of Port St. Lucie in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Village of North Palm Beach, located at 121 SW Port St. Lucie Boulevard, Port St. Lucie, FL 34984. The funding will be used to conduct a comprehensive Phase 3 Corridor Study and plan improvements along California Boulevard. This study will encompass the stretch of roadway extending from SW Savona Boulevard to SW Cameo Boulevard. The primary objective of the project is to thoroughly evaluate existing conditions and design targeted improvements that will significantly enhance traffic flow, bolster safety, and increase accessibility along this vital transportation corridor. sanitation operations, stormwater and utility support functions, and emergency response staging.

This is an appropriate use of taxpayers funds because the project will enhance connectivity in Port St. Lucie and ensure safer and more accessible routes for pedestrians, cyclists, and motorists alike. By enhancing transportation options, a Complete Street on SW California Boulevard will contribute to the economic development of the area, ultimately helping to expand the middle class and create a more vibrant, thriving community.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 23 U.S.C. 133.
